Fashion colors for Spring tend to be in the pastel range with a showing of pinks, buttercup yellow, sky blue, lilac, mint and a surprising Kelly Green as main color and accent. Yarns continue to lean toward the novelty type with new types of ladder yarn (Eros) being spun in double widths, and wavy ladders. Many new ribbon yarns abound in silky rayon's, cotton's, suede types, all in various widths. Lots of silver metallic being shown.

It's crocheted in the round with an easy lattice stitch. Only 4 balls: a smooth wool, rayon ribbon, and demure eyelash Match your Capelet to a favorite dress or slacks and you have a new look for Spring.

We've done sweaters. and accessories such as eyeglass cases and felted bags. Try your hand at Duo, and check out the Felting WORKSHOP (see page 6) Reg. \$9.50, on sale for \$7.

Basically Brilliant Knits (book) as the name implies, knit any of the gorgeous designs without getting overwhelmed by details. Pair classic shapes with a dash of contemporary. Easy stitches, and minimal shaping. WOW!. Knit a garment and finish it in the Finishing WORKSHOP (see pg 6) Reg. \$34.95, on Sale \$24.95.

### **New Yarns**

Ribbon yarns were everywhere at the show., in cotton, suede type, silk, rayon, and more. Used for sleeveless pullovers, and summer tops, handbags, and trimming. Ranging from a narrow 1/8 inch to a wide 3/4 inch. They're fun to knit with.

New ladder type yarns such as *Eros* (\$12);

some double wide, some with wavy ladders, and others with added metallic or novelty tiny "flowers". *Eros* is *THE YARN* for scarves, as it knits well on its own and combines equally well with other yarns, creating little jewels in the knitted fabric.

Manos Del Uruguay (\$12.50) hand dyed, striated wool for Uruguay. I couldn't resist the beautiful colors, and, it's reported to be a great felting yarn. Can't wait to try it! The shipment should be in by the time you receive this newsletter. Large skeins of 138yds/100G. Use #8-10 needle for 4 1/2 - 3 1/2 sts to the inch.

Star City (\$12) another specially hand dyed yarn from Wool in the Woods. Same great colors as Sophie (see "Sophie Hat" under What's Knitting at Our Shop, next page) This is Vanessa's favorite yarn to knit and felt with. We hope you like too!

Debbie Bliss Yarns, if you like her design books, you'll love her yarn as much as we do. Try the Alpaca Silk (\$9) for a luxurious sweater. There's also Cashmerino (\$9.50) and Cashmerino Super (\$16.50) . Stop in to see and feel this superb yarn along with the accompanying new pattern books. Vanessa knit a pretty pink cabled front sweater in the Cashmerino Super.

Baby Alpaca Brush (\$8) in a girl's Capelet. We used a soft sky blue hue, knit from the neck down in stockinet stitch, with garter ridge row about every inch. Add some lovely buttons and you may just have her new favorite cover-up. Pattern #IN76, \$4.95. 5 balls for 4-6 yr, 7 balls for 8-10 yr.

Sophie Felted Hat with Gossamer. A new line of mohair and wool yarn, Sophie (\$19) comes from Wool in the Woods and was hand dyed to our color specs. Lovely space dyed blends of pink/green/aqua or more dramatic burgundy, colors of royal, chocolate. 200yds/skein. Our hat done in the pink blend above with pink and silver Gossamer (\$24) for a hint of metallic. Fiber Trends patt. #AC-01, \$4.95. Quite lovely! Want to try your hand at felting? **Galway Leaf Sweater (\$8),** I finally got around to kniting a sweater for myself in Galway wool with celery and oregano colors. A Leaf Motif with an interesting negative/positive design adorns the front. Cabled rib bands make it interesting. Want to learn cabled rib? Check out the Cable WORKSHOP offered on page 6. Pattern #P427, \$4.95.

First Meryl and now Kitty are creating One-Of-A-Kind Cardigans with a myriad of novelty yarns. They've taught several others how to accomplish this easy technique, and want to share their knowledge. Stop in most weekdays 10-2 to see Kitty, and Tues - Fri 10-5 to see Meryl. It's EASY and FUN!

Fabric Handbag Kits (\$29). They're back! I remember these from the 70's! The kit comes complete with Fabric Strips, a matching fabric lining, cord handle and ornamental closure. 4 different styles, there's not one I don't like:

"Hobo" is denim,

"Peony" (shop model) is pinks and black, "Purple Gem" is PURPLE, and.... "Harvest" is Gold/Orange/Brown.

We had a lot of fun knitting the shop model, it's just simple stockinet stitch, and was finished with some hand stitching to secure the lining. Have fun!

Felted Footies for Children. (Slippers) This is free pattern from Brown Sheep to be use with their Lambs Pride Bulky Yarn. A great way to try a felting project without too much fuss as they take only 1-skein for Small and 2 skeins for Medium size. We'll have them at the Felting WORKSHOP (see page 6). 1 Footie will

be felted, the other one NOT, so you can see what happens after the felting process!

Beautiful Bears is a new Kit I fell in love with. Included in the LILY kit (\$30): 3 balls of white "Elle Lussuria"; (a really special, furry, bear type yarn), beautiful glass eyes, black nose, and ribbon for decoration. Purchase stuffing and furnish needles to create your bear masterpiece. For Podge kit (\$25) you receive cocoa brown boucle yarn and accessories same as above.
